

" deja vu" moments..... sometimes weekly, sometimes more often.


At my ripe old age of 66 ... I'm not going to jump out of my chair, like Tina did, when the next deja vu comes my way...

Honours Poster Presentation Friday 28 October 2016


> UNSW School of Chemical Engineering Honours Poster Presentation





Erathane BS22 helps keep Jetty Afloat

Five years ago, Tina and I, danced to a very special song;


" You Are The Best Thing That Ever Happened To Me "




